♦ I-75 FOG CRASH ANNIVERSARY

Tomorrow marks the 20th anniversary of a 99-vehicle pileup on fogenveloped I-75 at exit 36. A total of 12 people died and 42 were injured. As a result of the crash, the Tennessee Department of Transportation installed a high-tech fog warning system that automatically lowers the speed limit. There have been no fog-related pileups in the fog zone since the warning system was installed.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ♦ House Democrats voted Thursday to reject President Obama's tax deal with Republicans in its current form. By voice vote in a closed caucus meeting, the Democrats passed a resolution saying the tax package should not come to the House floor for consideration as written. They oppose extending Bush tax cuts to the most wealthy Americans.
- ♦ A new report says cigarette smoke causes immediate damage to a person's lungs and their DNA, even in small amounts, including the exposure from second-hand smoke.
- ♦ A new government study shows life expectancy of Americans has dropped slightly. Life expectancy dropped about a month, from 77.9 years in 2007 to 77.8 years in 2008. For the first time in 50 years, strokes dropped from the No. 3 leading cause of death. Chronic lower respiratory diseases moved into 3rd place.
- ♦ Facebook and Twitter have deleted the accounts of WikiLeaks supporters who targeted Visa and other Internet payment sites that tried to block donations to WikiLeaks after its release of secret U.S. diplomatic cables.
- ♦ Actor Wesley Snipes has begun serving a 3-year sentence at a federal prison in Pennsylvania for failing to file income tax returns.
