## State & Local News

### ◆ TENNESSEE LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

In the Tennessee General Assembly this week:

A bill to require a prescription to buy any cold medicine containing pseudoephedrine was killed by the House Human Resources Subcommittee. Instead, the panel passed a bill that would require all pharmacies in Tennessee to enter sales of pseudoephedrine products into an electronic database. The TBI says the database approach will not do much to stop the scourge of meth in the state.

Governor Haslam has signed his teacher tenure bill into law, changing a teacher's probationary period before becoming eligible for tenure from three years to five years. Haslam calls it a major education reform milestone.

A bill to allow the election of school superintendents by popular vote has been killed in the House Education Committee. School superintendents in Tennessee are currently appointed by the local school boards.

A proposal that would allow local law enforcement authorities to question suspects about their immigration status is one of three immigration bills to pass the House State and Local Government Committee.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ President Obama proposes lowering the nation's future deficits by \$4 trillion over a dozen years through reductions in Medicare spending increases, cuts in defense, and overhaul of the tax system to eliminate several loopholes, and an end to Bush era tax cuts for wealthier Americans.

◆ In Newburgh, New York, a mother and her three children--ages 5, 2, and 11 months--were found dead in a minivan when the mother drove into the Hudson River. A fourth child, a 10-year-old boy, managed to escape and stumble into the town's fire department to report that his mother had driven into the river. Police say Lashandra Armstrong, 25, intentionally drove into the river.

◆ Researchers at the University of Hawaii say the first wave of debris from the Japanese earthquake and tsunami is expected to reach Hawaii's main islands in two years and to arrive on the U.S. West Coast in three years.

◆ U.S. Internet advertising revenue hit a record \$26 billion last year. The revenue from Internet ads grew 15% from 2009.

◆ A Yale University student has been killed in an accident at a campus chemistry laboratory. Officials say Michele Dufault, a senior astronomy and physics major, died in some type of accident involving a piece of equipment that snagged her hair.
