### STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

#### ◆ WATTS BAR SAFETY MEETING SET

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will present the results of its recent safety assessment at the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant this Thursday from 2 to 4 p.m. at the Comfort Inn at 2811 Decatur Pike in Athens. NRC and TVA officials will be present to answer questions from the public.

- ✓ Athens Utilities Board power crews will be changing-out an old transformer and related wiring today. The work will require the closure of one lane of Railroad Avenue between Webb Street and Tellico Avenue from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- ✓ The Athens Parks Department and Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Tennessee urge you to join them to celebrate the National Walk at Lunch Day from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Veterans Memorial Park and Athens Regional Park. Pack your lunch, eat, and then walk.

### NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Afghanistan officials say at least 480 inmates escaped from the main prison in Kandahar through a 1,000-foot-long underground tunnel dug by Taliban militants over the last several months.
- ◆ NATO airstrikes destroyed a multi-story library and office in Moammar Gadhafi's Libyan compound on Monday. The bombs also badly damaged a reception hall for visiting dignitaries. Four people were injured.
- ◆ The U.S. Supreme Court refused on Monday to speed-up a ruling on President Obama's healthcare overhaul. The justices turned down the state of Virginia's request to invoke a rarely used procedure to bypass the normal appeals process and move quickly to a Supreme Court decision on the law's constitutionality.
- ◆ The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation says a piece of evidence has been found along a West Tennessee roadside that could lead them to 20-year-old Holly Bobo, the nursing student missing since April 13th.
- ◆ Nissan has recalled 271,000 older-model Pathfinder and Infiniti QX4 SUV's in North America due to the chance that road salt used to keep roads clear of snow and ice could collect and cause a loss of steering. The vehicles involved are Pathfinders from 1996 to 2004 and Infiniti QX4's from 1997 to 2003.

**1607** - The first British colonists to establish a permanent settlement in America landed at Cape Henry, Virginia.  
**1865** - Federal troops shot and killed John Wilkes Booth, the assassin of President Abraham Lincoln. He was shot inside a burning barn near Port Royal, Virginia, despite orders to capture him alive.  
**1933** - Actress Carol Burnett was born.  
**1938** - Duane Eddy, famous for his "twangy guitar," was born. His biggest hit record was "Rebel Rouser."  
**1942** - Singer Bobby Rydell was born. Among his hit records- "Swingin' School" and "Volare."  
**1986** - History's worst-ever nuclear disaster occurred at the Chernobyl Nuclear Plant in the Soviet Ukraine. It sent a radioactive cloud into the atmosphere which increased radiation levels in several European countries.
