STATE AND LOCAL NEWS

◆ ARCH CHEMICAL FIRE INJURES FIVE

An explosion and fire at Arch Chemical in Charleston sent 5 people to area hospitals Monday afternoon. The victims were treated for burns, smoke inhalation, and heat exhaustion; none apparently received life threatening injuries. No word on the cause of the fire.

◆ CREDIT UNION BURGLARY FOILED

Athens police are investigating an attempted weekend burglary at the Southeast Financial Credit Union in the Food Lion Shopping Center. Police say the burglars entered the building by punching a hole through the wall from a vacant office next door. They drilled several holes in the safe, but were not able to get it open. The burglars were not able to get any money, but they did manage to remove the tape from the security system before leaving.

◆ COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE

✓ Today is Flag Day. The American Legion Post in Athens will have a "flag disposal demonstration" at 5 p.m. today at the Flag Memorial at I-75 and exit 49. The public is invited to come see the proper method for disposing worn out flags. Anyone who has a flag they would like to have disposed, just bring it to the VFW on Congress Parkway. There is an old mail box that has been converted to a flag disposal receptacle.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Thousands of Syrians have poured across the border to refugee camps in Turkey, fleeing a military crackdown in a province in the northern part of Syria.

◆ Facebook is getting ready to file for an initial public offering of its stock that could make the value of the popular social networking site more than \$100 billion.

◆ A federal judge in Knoxville has refused to dismiss an indictment against a Georgia man charged with traveling to East Tennessee with firearms. Darren Wesley Huff allegedly planned to take over the Monroe County Courthouse after a grand jury failed to indict President Obama because he had not produced his birth certificate. The case is set for Aug. 16.

◆ A World War II B-17 bomber crashed and burned Monday in a cornfield outside Chicago. The pilot reported a fire shortly after departure and put the plane down in a cornfield. Those on board escaped uninjured.

◆ Carl Gardner, the lead singer of The Coasters, died June 12 in Florida at the age of 83. Their hits included "Yakety-Yak" and "Charlie Brown."

◆ Radio preacher Harold Camping, who predicted the Rapture would occur on May 21st, is hospitalized in California after suffering a stroke.

THIS DAY IN HISTORY-June 14

1775 - The U.S. Army was founded. Congress authorized the recruitment of 10 companies of riflemen to serve one year.

1777 - The U.S. Continental Congress adopted the nation's flag. The flag has several names, including "Stars and Stripes," "Star-Spangled Banner," and "Old Glory." Today, by the way, is Flag Day.

1900 - The islands of Hawaii became a U.S. territory. The islanders became American citizens, but could not vote in presidential elections until Hawaii became the 50th state in 1959.

1909 - Actor and singer Burl Ives was born. He died in 1995.

1919 - The first transatlantic airplane flight was made on this day when pilot John William Alcock and his navigator landed in Ireland. They had flown the 1,960 miles from St. Johns, Newfoundland, to Ireland in just under 16½ hours.
