NATIONAL-WORLD

- ◆ House Speaker John Boehner has joined President Obama and a growing number of Democratic House members in suggesting that Rep. Anthony Weiner resign. A member of Weiner's New York congressional delegation says she expects him to quit soon.
- ◆ Republican presidential contenders focused their attacks on President Obama and refrained from attacking each other Monday night in their first major debate of the 2012 campaign.
- ◆ President Obama warned on Tuesday that there could be another global financial crisis if Congress fails to raise the national debt ceiling.
- ◆ Stocks jumped more than 1 percent on Tuesday as investors reacted positively to better than expected retail sales data. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,076.11; up 123.14.
- ◆ The number of firefighters killed in the line of duty dropped to 72 in 2010, the lowest number since at least 1977. The National Fire Protection Association says the record low is largely due to advances in training, equipment and fire codes. Most of the deaths resulted from overexertion, stress, and medical issues.
- ◆ Police in Colorado say a woman robbed a bank by passing a note saying she would infect a teller with AIDS unless she handed over the money.
