◆ JORDAN TO BE TRIED AS AN ADULT

Curtis Jordan, III, (right) will be tried as an adult for the murder of his father, Curtis "Kirk" Jordan, II, on January 10, 2010, at the family's home in Riceville. Jordan was arrested this past March in Roane County. He was a juvenile at the time of the murder, but is now 18. The District Attorney's office says the case has been transferred to adult court and will go to the grand jury.



◆ NRC TO DISCUSS WATTS BAR TODAY

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will hold a meeting at noon today at the Comfort Inn, 2811 Decatur Pike, in Athens to get an update from TVA on the construction on the Unit 2 reactor at Watts Bar. Following the business portion of the meeting, the public will be allowed to ask questions and talk with NRC officials.

◆ INMATES MAY BE PUT TO WORK

McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy and County Mayor John Gentry are working on a plan to put inmates at the County Justice Center to work. Once details are worked out, the inmates will be used for general labor, such as landscaping, painting, and cleaning.

◆ Outgoing Defense Secretary Robert Gates says U.S. forces are doing a great job in Afghanistan, and people need to be patient and consider the consequences of failure if the U.S. were to pull out prematurely.

◆ The American Cancer Society says cancer death rates are continuing to fall. The report says, however, that Americans with the least education are twice as likely to die from cancer. Lung cancer remains the #1 cancer killer of both men and women. Breast cancer is #2 for women, while prostate cancer is #2 for men. Colon cancer is the 3rd-leading cause of cancer deaths for both sexes.
