## STATE & LOCAL NEWS

### ◆ ROBBERY RINGLEADER NABBED

Police in Charleston, South Carolina, have arrested the suspected ringleader of a group of robbers who have targeted drug stores in five states around the southeast, including Athens. Earlier, two male suspects were arrested in Crossville. They have been identified as Aaron Dale Reynolds, 28, and Arnulfo Ray Canales, 26. Chattanooga police have been able to connect them to the robbery of a CVS pharmacy on July 9th. They are also suspected of robberies at the Walgreens Drug Store on Congress Parkway in Athens. Other arrests are pending.

### ◆ DOWNTOWN AREA MARRED BY GRAFFITI

Athens police are investigating the spraying of graffiti on several buildings and vehicles in downtown Athens this past weekend. Graffiti was sprayed on several SETHRA buses and also on the rear of the SETHRA office building on N. Jackson Street. Graffiti slogans were also sprayed on the side of the Johnson Real Estate Building. Police Chief Chuck Ziegler says there is no indication that the graffiti is gang-related.

## NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ White House spokesman Jay Carney reports little progress toward reaching a compromise on the debt ceiling issue. Carney said: "There is no deal, we are not close to a deal." House Speaker John Boehner also says there is no deal. However, he is predicting that a majority of House Republicans will end up supporting some kind of compromise.

◆ Stocks shot up 164 points Thursday after reports that the White House and Speaker Boehner were close to a budget agreement. But prices fell back after both the White House and Boehner denied a deal was close to being reached. The Dow Jones Industrial Average closed at 12,724.41; up 152.50 points.

◆ The Federal Election Commission says former presidential candidate John Edwards' campaign owes the government more than \$2 million. The former senator from North Carolina also faces other legal woes. He was indicted on June 3rd for allegedly using \$1 million in illegal campaign funds to cover up an extramarital affair with a campaign aide while he was running for president.

◆ Actress Lindsay Lohan has been sued for \$1 million for allegedly assaulting an employee of the California rehab center where the actress spent three months in treatment for drug and alcohol abuse.
