Local & State News

◆ MOONSHINE STILL FOUND IN McMINN CO.

It's been decades since a moonshining operation has been found in McMinn County. But that's what Sheriff Joe Guy and Lt. Detective Eric Allman located in an old dairy barn on County Road 881 at the foot of Starr Mountain Tuesday morning. Sheriff Guy says a tip led them to the barn, where they found the still and five 50 gallon barrels of muscadine and apple wine known as "wineshine". A small amount of marijuana as well as a "mini-still" were found. Sheriff Guy says it was fairly common for sheriffs to find stills in East Tennessee, 60 or 70 years ago. Arrests are expected.



NATIONAL-WORLD NEWS

- ◆ ABC News reports that FBI and DEA agents have disrupted a terrorist plot to assassinate the Saudi Arabian ambassador to the United States with a bomb and subsequent bomb attacks on the Saudi and Israeli embassies in Washington. The plot reportedly was directed by Iran. Two suspects are under arrest.
- ◆ New Jersey Governor Chris Christie has endorsed Mitt Romney for the Republican presidential nomination.
- ◆ Stocks were little changed on Tuesday, with major indices seeing gains and losses before a key vote by Slovakia on expanding the euro zone rescue fund. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 16.88 at 11,416.30.
- ◆ Police in Boston arrested 129 protesters after the Occupy Boston group tried to expand its camp beyond Dewey Square Park. Police handcuffed protesters and tore down their tents.
- ◆ What a day for Amber Miller. The 27-year-old woman ran the Chicago Marathon this past Sunday even though she was 39 weeks pregnant. Shortly after finishing the race, she went into labor, went to the hospital, and gave birth.
- ◆ Forbes magazine says Sarah Lawrence College in New York is the most expensive college in the nation, at \$58,334 a year. The University of Chicago is second at \$57,590.
