STATE & LOCAL NEWS

◆ BODY FOUND NEAR CALHOUN

The McMinn County Sheriff's Office and the TBI are trying to determine the identity of a body that was found near the railroad tracks off U.S. 11 just north of Calhoun Thursday. Sheriff Joe Guy says the remains were badly decomposed and had been there for some time. He says the age, sex, race and cause of death are unknown.

◆ CIVIL WAR ARCHIVISTS TO VISIT McMINN

Representatives from the Tennessee State Library and the Tennessee State Museum will be in Athens on November 16th and 17th to record and digitize Civil War memorabilia owned by McMinn County residents. The photographs are for a new exhibit to commemorate the 150th anniversary of the Civil War. If you have any Civil War documents, photographs, or artifacts, you are invited to bring them to the McMinn Living Heritage Museum from 2 to 6 p.m. on the 16th or from 9 a.m. until noon on the 17th.

◆ VETERANS TO BE HONORED TOMORROW

The 2nd annual Elks Lodge Veterans Day Parade will be held at 4 p.m. tomorrow in downtown Athens. The parade will start at the Courthouse Annex and end at the new Farmers Market Pavilion with a concert by the Etowah Town Band and barbeque sandwiches.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Greece's prime minister abandoned his plan to put a European debt rescue deal to a popular vote. The news sent stocks higher on the New York Stock Exchange. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 208.43 at 12,044.47.

◆ One of the women who accused Republican frontrunner Herman Cain of sexual harassment has decided not to go public. Her lawyer says the Maryland woman does not want to become another Anita Hill. Hill's accusations of inappropriate sexual statements by now Supreme Court Justice Clarence Thomas surfaced in 1991 when Congress held confirmation hearings for Thomas.

◆ A House Energy and Commerce subcommittee has voted to subpoena the White House for documents related to Solyndra, the failed solar company that received a half-billion-dollar federal loan.

◆ New research by Canadian doctors say the hours we spend sitting may increase our risk of cancer. The study says there is convincing evidence that being physically active reduces the risk of developing colon and breast cancer. For colon cancer, regular exercise can reduce the risk up to 35 percent.
