STATE & LOCAL NEWS

◆ DISASTER RELIEF CENTERS NOW OPEN

TEMA and FEMA have opened disaster recovery centers in McMinn and Monroe counties to help those whose homes or businesses were affected by the tornado earlier this month. For McMinn and Polk county residents, the center is located at the Etowah Rural Fire and Rescue building at 1018 Tennessee Avenue, Etowah. For Monroe County, the center is at the Tellico Plains Community Center, 132 Bank Street. The centers will be open from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday and from 1 to 6 p.m. on Sunday until further notice.

- ✓ Anyone wanting to get a brick, or a truckload of bricks, from the old Etowah grammar school-community center can go by and get as many as you want. There are at least 150,000 bricks remaining. After this week, the site will be cleared...so you need to go by and load up right away.
- ✓ The Central Charger football team will hold an all you can eat pancake breakfast Saturday from 7 to 10 a.m. at Applebee's in Athens. The cost is \$5.00. All proceeds go to the McMinn Central football team.


NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Volkswagen says it will hire 800 more workers by the end of this year, bringing its workforce to 3,500 at its new assembly plant in Chattanooga. VW also says it will increase its production to 170,000 Passats a year.
- ◆ President Obama says he is directing federal agencies to put a 485-mile oil pipeline from Oklahoma to refineries on the Texas Gulf Coast on a "fast track." The president also defended his record on oil drilling and criticized Congress for refusing to give his administration enough time to review the larger Canada-to-the-Gulf Keystone pipeline.
- ◆ The French gunman who confessed to killing seven people in the city of Toulouse is dead after being shot in the head by a police sniper during a final dramatic shootout with French police. It was the culmination of a 31-hour standoff with hundreds of French anti-terror police who had surrounded the building where the gunman had barricaded himself.
- ◆ The number of Americans filing for new unemployment benefits dropped to a four-year low last week. Initial claims for state unemployment benefits fell by 5,000. On Wall Street, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 78.48 at 13,046.14.

Preparing for an Emergency

The Athens Police Department has issued some tips for deal-
ing with severe weather situations. They include teaching chil-
dren how and when to call 911 and how to turn on the radio for
emergency information. Learning how to turn off the water,
gas, and electricity to your house. Posting emergency numbers
near telephones. And picking two meeting places.

The APD also advises you to prepare a disaster supplies kit
which includes a supply of water and non-perishable food in-
cluding a non-electric can opener, blankets or sleeping bags, a
change of clothing, rain gear, and sturdy shoes, a first aid kit
and prescription medications, and an extra pair of glasses. You
should have a battery powered radio, flashlight, and plenty of
extra batteries, and a cellular telephone. It 's also wise to have
credit cards and cash and an extra set of car keys.
