Local and State News

◆ TIME TO CAST YOUR BALLOT

The polls will be opened from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. today for those of you who have not already voted early in the county primary. The most contested races in McMinn County are the Republican primary contest between incumbent Sheriff Joe Guy and challenger Tim Smith. Four Republican candidates are after the Property Assessor's job: Bobby Case, Johnny Johnson, Susie Lee, and interim Assessor Keith Price. Three candidates are running in the Republican primary for County Mayor: incumbent John Gentry, Tracy Carter, and Kelly Shepherd. In the Republican primary for Highway Commissioner, Dan Evans and Carl Mashburn both want the job. Steve Crump and Stephen Hatchett are the Republican candidates for District Attorney. Sandra Donaghy and Van Irion are the Republican candidates for Criminal Court Judge. And William Brown, Andrew Freiberg, and Chal Thompson are running in the Republican primary for Circuit Court Judge.

◆ POTENTIAL CONFUSION FOR DISTRICT 4 VOTERS

The McMinn County Election Commission reports that an article in Monday's DPA says that the District 4; Precinct 2 polling place is Etowah City School, which is incorrect. The actual polling place is the Etowah Community Center.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ Electronic data from a single plane's flight plan caused the failure of the primary air traffic control system at the Los Angeles en route center in Southern California last week. The glitch confused the system's software and shut down Los Angeles area travel. An FAA spokesman said that it was an individual flight plan and the issue had to do with the way it was coded. The en route center controls high altitude air traffic over southern and central California, southern Nevada, southwestern Utah and western Arizona, except airspace designated for military use.

◆ A wildfire in Guthrie, Oklahoma, about 35 miles north of Oklahoma City, went awry Sunday and swept through the parched countryside with wind gusts at 31 mph. Fire officials said that the blaze was about 75 percent contained and they are investigating to determine whether any criminal conduct occurred when it was set. Thousands of acres were burned and 6 homes were destroyed with one person confirmed killed in the blaze.

◆ More than 60 pounds of gold were recovered from an infamous 157-year-old shipwreck 160 miles off the coast of South Carolina. The deep-sea exploration company that retrieved the gold says there is plenty more down there.
