### Local & State News

#### ◆ GUY AND GENTRY BIG PRIMARY WINNERS

Joe Guy (right) will be the McMinn County Sheriff for another term. Guy defeated Tim Smith in Tuesday's county primary by a vote of 4,542 to 2,686. Since there were no Democrats running, Joe Guy is automatically re-elected.



McMinn County Mayor John Gentry (left) also won another term by defeating two Republican challengers. Gentry received 4,187 votes, Kelly Shepherd was second with 2,468, and Tracy Carter finished 3rd with 442. There were no Democrats running for County Mayor.

In the Highway Commissioner's race, Dan Evans defeated Carl Mashburn in the Republican primary by a vote of 4,554 to 2,053. Evans will face Democrat Randy Moss in the August general election. Moss received 408 complimentary votes in the Democratic primary. **(More primary results are on Page 2)**

### NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

◆ At least 50 people in Kenya have died from drinking illegal liquor. Dozens more people were hospitalized and several went blind. Drinking dens selling illicit home brews from jerry cans are common in the back streets of many towns and villages in Kenya.

◆ Access to the White House complex was halted for about an hour Tuesday after a vehicle followed a motorcade carrying President Barack Obama's daughters through the gates. Uniformed agents immediately stopped the vehicle after it trailed in behind the motorcade. The driver, identified as Mathew Evan Goldstein, 55, was arrested and charged with unlawful entry. He did not make entry onto the White House grounds.

◆ May 6 through 12 is National Nurses Week. The week is set aside to recognize the integral role nurses play in our hospitals and communities. May 12 is an important date in the history of nursing because it's the birth date of Florence Nightingale, the founder of modern nursing. She became famous providing innovative health care to British soldiers during the Crimean War. After the war, she established the world's first nursing school in London.

◆ After decades of maintaining a low profile, Monica Lewinsky is breaking her silence. She insists that her affair with President Clinton was "one between two consenting adults."

In the Republican primary for Property Assessor, Keith Price defeated Susie Gaston Lee by just 37 votes.

In the District Attorney Republican primary, Steve Crump defeated Stephen Hatchett.

For Circuit Court Judge Part III, Andrew Freiberg finished first in the Republican primary.

In the Republican primary for Criminal Court Judge, the winner was Sandra Donaghy. Donaghy will face Democrat incumbent Amy Reedy in the August general election.
