Local & State News

- ◆ **COMMUNITY NEWS YOU CAN USE:**
 - ✓ Medic Regional Blood Center will be at the Starr Regional Medical Center Athens campus today from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. All donors will receive a coupon for a free Chick-fil-A sandwich. Medic will be at Big Lots of Athens on August 4th and the The Surgery Center of Athens at 105 North Meadows Drive on August 13th. - ◆ **TENNESSEE AREA NEWS BRIEFS:**
 - ✓ What's the leading cause of death in Tennessee? It's drug overdoses. Last year 1,166 people died from drug overdoses while 1,008 died in motor vehicle accidents. Homicides accounted for 405 deaths in Tennessee last year.
 - ✓ The remains of a WWII veteran from East Tennessee were recently found in a makeshift grave in France by some hikers. DNA tests confirmed that the remains were those of Army PFC Cecil Edwin Harris of Johnson City. He was declared missing in action in 1945. Harris will be buried in Arlington National Cemetery on October 22nd.

NATIONAL & WORLD NEWS

- ◆ Israel has unleashed its heaviest bombardment in a 3-week-old war against Hamas, striking symbols of the militant group's control in Gaza and firing tank shells that Palestinian officials said shut down the strip's only power plant. Over 1,200 Palestinians have died so far, compared to 51 soldiers from Israel.
- ◆ Residents of Mosul, Iraq are watching helplessly as extremists ruling the northern Iraqi city blow up some of their most beloved landmarks and shrines to impose a stark vision of Islam. They fear that next on the list of destruction will be the Crooked Minaret, a more than 840-year-old tower that leans like Italy's Tower of Pisa.
- ◆ A 9-year-old girl has died from injuries suffered when she was hit by an airplane that crash-landed on Caspersen Beach in Venice, Florida where she was walking with her father. The 1972 Piper Cherokee plane made an emergency landing after reporting mechanical problems.
- ◆ The NCAA is creating a \$70 million fund as of a result of settling a class-action head injury lawsuit. The fund will be used to help diagnose thousands of current and former college athletes to determine if they suffered brain trauma playing football, hockey, soccer and other contact sports.

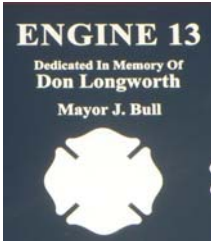
