State and Local News

◆ ONE DEAD, ONE WOUNDED IN MEIGS CO.

The TBI is investigating a shooting in Meigs County that left one man dead and another man wounded. The Meigs County Sheriff's Office says officers responded to a shooting early Wednesday morning on Moore Cemetery Road. They found Tim Johnson, 52, in the driveway, dead from a gunshot. They found his nephew, Larry Johnson, 27, inside the house on a bed. He had also been shot. He was taken to UT Medical Center and is listed in critical condition. Deputies say the men shot each other. Police say the shooting occurred over the alleged theft of Tim Johnson's prize fighting rooster.

◆ POWER RATES TO DROP IN OCTOBER

Despite a TVA increase in base power rates set to take effect on October 1st, Athens Utilities Board says local power rates will decrease. AUB spokesman Wayne Scarbrough says September is part of TVA's summer season, but October is a transition month and transition months have the lowest base rates of the year.

◆ The Federal Reserve announced that it is leaving interest rates unchanged.

◆ General Motors has agreed to a \$900 million settlement and agreed to admit to misleading the public about vehicle safety amid defective ignition switches.

◆ President Obama welcomed the three Americans who thwarted a terrorist attack on-board a train in France in August to the Oval Office Thursday. He credited their courage and teamwork for pinning down the gunman and saving countless lives.

◆ Following a computer glitch, American Airlines flights were grounded at Dallas-Fort Worth, Chicago O'Hare, and Miami Thursday afternoon.

◆ Stocks closed mixed on Thursday as the Fed chose not to raise interest rates. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 65.21 at 16,674.74. The Nasdaq gained 4.71 at 4,893.95, and the S&P 500 finished the session down 5.11 at 1,990.20.
