STATE & LOCAL NEWS

♦ UTILITY RATES TO DIP IN JANUARY

The price for a kilowatt hour of power from AUB will fall slightly in January compared to December. The difference will shave about \$1.44 off of the bill for the average AUB customer. AUB's Wayne Scarbrough says the slight January dip is based on TVA issuing lower generation fuel charges to power distributors for the period.

♦ NOVEMBER POLICE AND FIRE REPORTS

Members of the Athens City Council received the reports on police and fire department activity for the month of November at their monthly meeting Tuesday night.

Police Chief Chuck Ziegler's final report before his retirement showed there were 49 thefts in Athens in November, 18 burglaries, 11 assaults, three motor vehicle thefts, two sex offenses, and one robbery. Police officers issued 555 citations for moving violations. There were 42 traffic accidents in November, with 14 injuries.

Fire Chief Jim Dyer reported that Athens firefighters responded to 76 calls in November. There were two residential fires, seven vehicle accidents, six trash fires, four grass fires, and one vehicle fire. Damages for the month totaled \$50,450.

◆ The Federal Aviation Administration has launched an investigation after an air traffic controller accidentally told a pilot to turn the wrong way, sending the Boeing 777 dangerously close to Southern California's largest mountain range.

◆ Authorities believe the Berlin truck attacker is still in the country and warn that the suspect is likely armed. Germany's Interior Ministry confirmed that the suspect has been identified as a 24-year-old Tunisian man.
