**THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT:** U.S. stocks ticked down as analysts suggested the post-election rally is catching its breath as the Christmas holiday weekend gets under way. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 23.08 at 19,918.88. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 4.22 at 2,260.96, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 24.01 at 5,447.42.

In Commodity markets, the spot price of gold fell \$2.48 to \$1,129.12. The spot price of silver fell \$0.12 to \$15.81, and crude oil prices rose \$0.12 to \$52.61.
