♦ FORMER FIREFIGHTER GETS PROBATION

Former Union Grove firefighter, Donna Hurst of Sweetwater, has pleaded guilty to one count of forgery and one count of theft that occurred about 3 and-a-half years ago while she was treasurer of the fire department. The theft was discovered when a Union Grove volunteer firefighter gassed up a fire truck after returning from a fire and discovered there was no money in the fire department's bank account to pay for it. After an investigation by the state comptroller's office, Hurst was charged with 20 counts of forgery and one count of theft over \$1,000. She appeared in McMinn County court this past December and entered a guilty plea to two counts. The other charges were dismissed. She was sentenced to two years of probation and was ordered to pay court costs and to make restitution of \$1,000 to the McMinn County government's fire department fund.
