One person was killed Saturday afternoon when an RV slammed into the rear of an 18wheeler at the I-75 northbound exit ramp at exit 49. Two occupants of the RV were airlifted to UT Medical Center, where one later died. She was a 70vear-old woman from Toledo, Ohio. The THP says a tire blew out on the RV, causing it to veer into the rear of the truck. Two people in the truck were hurt.

- ◆ British Prime Minister Theresa May has condemned the "evil ideology" behind the London terror attacks Saturday night that left at least seven people dead and more than 40 injured. Terrorists plowed into pedestrians on the London Bridge and then stabbed passersby at a nearby market.
- Republican Mark Green has closed the door on re-starting his race for Governor of Tennessee. Green put his campaign on hold when he was nominated by President Trump to be Army Secretary. Green later withdrew his name. He says he is considering several options that will allow him to serve the country.
