JASON PICKEL TO RUN FOR SHERIFF

The McMinn County Primary Election is 11 months away, but a candidate has already tossed his hat into the ring for Sheriff.



hat into the ring for Sheriff. Englewood Police Chief Jason Pickel has announced that he will challenge Sheriff Joe Guy. Pickel comes from a family with a long history of public service. His grandmother, Nadean Cunningham, was Register of Deeds. His uncle, Gary Mason, served as a County Commissioner. His father, Steve Pickel, ran unsuccessfully for Sheriff in

1994. He says he applied for a job with the Sheriff's Office while volunteering for the McMinn County Rescue Squad. Pickel went to work for Sheriff Steve Frisbie on Sept. 11, 2001. He was a deputy for eight years, reaching the rank of Sergeant. He also worked as a Narcotics Officer and a School Resource Officer. He currently serves as the Police Chief of Englewood. He says the thought of being able to serve his community from the highest position in law enforcement would be an opportunity of a life-time. The McMinn County Primary is May 1st, 2018.


