- ◆ President Trump has responded to former FBI Director James Comey's testimony by tweeting, "Total and complete vindication, and, wow, Comey is a leaker." During his testimony, Comey admitted he leaked memos about his conservations with the president in hopes of prompting the appointment of a special counsel to investigate Russian interference in the election. He testified that Trump asked him to declare publicly that Trump was not a target of the FBI probe into his campaign's Russian ties. Comey said Trump had spread lies about him and the FBI. Comey's testimony exonerated Trump of obstruction of justice. He said Trump told him he "hoped" he could drop the investigation of former National Security Adviser Michael Flynn, but conceded Trump did not directly order him to.
- ♦ A church bus with Alabama high schoolers on board overturned while heading to the Atlanta airport Thursday afternoon. One person died and several others were critically injured.
