

◆ MISSING K-9 OFFICER FOUND IN McMINN

The Bradley County Sheriff's Office says the body of their miss-

ing K-9 officer, Lucy, a Belgium Malinois, was discovered Monday morning lying next to railroad tracks in McMinn County. Lucy's handler, Deputy Chris Shope, was on vacation, and his dog was being boarded at a Charleston kennel. Caretakers discovered that Lucy's kennel was empty on Sunday. Investigators believe she was struck by a train. Sheriff Eric Watson said that Lucy will be buried with full honors.

- ◆ Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer mocked President Donald Trump's Monday cabinet meeting with a parody video on Twitter, which opened with each cabinet member thanking and praising the new administration. Schumer tweeted, "GREAT meeting today with the best staff in the history of the world!!!"
- Richard Jones, who was imprisoned for 17 years for a crime he has always said he didn't commit, is now free after a lookalike mix-up. Jones was charged with aggravated robbery in Kansas City for trying to steal a purse in the parking lot of a Walmart in Roeland Park, Kansas. There was no DNA evidence to link him to the crime, and he had an alibi. Eyewitness testimony identified him as the robber, which was the sole basis for his conviction. The lookalike, Ricky Amos, is serving time in the Kansas state system and is denying any involvement in the crime.
