

◆ VOLUNTEERS NEEDED FOR RAM CLINIC

Remote Area Medical (RAM) will be holding a free clinic at McMinn County High School in Athens on July 8th and 9th. There will be free vision, dental, and medical care to anyone, regardless of insurance. The services include cleaning, filling, and extracting teeth, eyeglass prescriptions and even free eyeglasses. More than 100 dentists, dental students, and dental hygienists are volunteering their time, along with a dozen doctors and nurse practitioners, and 18 optometrists. Volunteers are still needed. To volunteer or to ask questions, call Mary Brown at 506-1404. The parking lot at the high school will open at 12 a.m. Saturday, July 8th and Sunday, July 9th. Ticket distribution will begin at 3 a.m. and the doors will open at 6 a.m. both days. People will be called in order by the number on their ticket and will be served on a first -come, first-served basis. All services are provided at no cost to patients of any age, and no ID is required. Patients 17 and under need to be accompanied by an adult. The clinic hours will be 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and 6 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Sunday. Ms. Brown says they hope to see 1,000 to 2,000 patients.
