◆ THP OFFERS HALLOWEEN SAFETY TIPS

Last year, 17 people were killed in Tennessee during the Halloween holiday. Seven of the 17 fatal crashes were alcohol related. As of October 24th, there have been 99 pedestrian fatalities in Tennessee. THP Colonel Tracy Trott urges drivers to keep children safe tonight by not drinking and driving. The THP will be conducting sobriety checkpoints.

On Monday, federal court Judge Colleen Kollar-Kotelly in Washington, D.C., largely blocked President Trump's controversial ban on transgender people serving in the military. The judge issued a preliminary injunction on his reinstatement of the ban on transgender service members that was in place before June 2016. and temporarily stopped Trump's move to block recruiting openly transgender people for the military. She did not block the portion of the memo directing that government funds may not be used for sex reassignment procedures.

Today, October 31st, marks the 500th anniversary of the Protestant Reformation, the day Martin Luther nailed his *Ninety-five Theses* to the door of a Roman Catholic Church in Wittenberg, Germany.
