♦ AUDIT SAYS TVA WAS OVERCHARGED

An audit says a contractor, Bechtel Power Corp., overcharged TVA by more than \$6.8 million to help finish construction on the Unit 2 reactor at Watts Bar Nuclear Plant. The Chattanooga Times Free Press says TVA's Office of Inspector General claims Bechtel overcharged for overtime, meal expenses, craft labor costs, and an incorrect rate for a veteran construction program. Bechtel disagrees with the findings. TVA says it is negotiating with Bechtel over proper payments.

♦ FORGETY TO SERVE ON WELLNESS CAUCUS

State Rep. John Forgety of Athens has been named to serve on a new Wellness Caucus created by members of the Tennessee General Assembly. The caucus consists of 37 members from both the House and Senate who will study and propose new solutions to important health and wellness issues in communities across the state. Rep. Forgety says "as a former coach and physical education instructor, health and wellness have always been very important aspects of my life."



Is It Coach Greg Schiano?

Multiple news outlets, including ESPN and USA Today, are reporting that Ohio State University defensive coordinator Greg Schiano is in line to be named the new UT Vol head football coach. Schiano was head coach at Rutgers for 12 years with a 68-67 record. He was coach of the Tampa Bay Bucaneers, with a record of 11 wins and 21 losses. Many Vol fans are not happy with the possible choice of Schiano. Among other things, they're upset over reports that he knew about the child sex abuse scandal at Penn State while he was an assistant coach there. Meanwhile, the Vols ended their season by losing to Vanderbilt, 42-14.
