UNEMPLOYMENT RISES A BIT IN THE AREA

The unemployment rate in Tennessee remains at record lows, but the rate did go up slightly in the Athens area last month. The jobless rate in McMinn County was 3.6% in October, up from 3.3% in September. Meigs County recorded an unemployment rate of 4.1% in October, up from 3.3% in September. Monroe County's jobless rate was 3.3% in October, up from 3.0% in September. Polk County's unemployment rate went up from 3.3% in September to 3.6% in October. The jobless rate for Bradley County also went up, from 2.7% in September to 2.9% in October. Rhea County continued to have the highest unemployment rate in the state, 5.4% in October, up from 4.9% in September.
