◆ TORNADO HITS ONE YEAR AGO TODAY!

In the early morning hours of November 30th one year ago today a tornado touched down in the Cedar Springs Road area of McMinn County. It's path covered about 11 miles to northern McMinn County, causing damage and destruction to several businesses, churches, and homes along the way. The heaviest damage was in the South White Street and Fairview Road areas of Athens, and the Deerfield Estates area along Highway 307. The Daily Post-Athenian, Save-A-Lot, C & D Tire, and WYXI Radio buildings were heavily damaged. The photo shows what was left of Save-A-Lot. In the year since then, Save-A-Lot and WYXI Radio have rebuilt. The DPA is planning to return to its building on S. Jackson Street within the next few days, Fairview Christian Academy has broken ground for a new facility, and many of the Deerfield Estates homes have been repaired or rebuilt. But, the memories live on.

- ♦ A Florida woman allegedly killed by her teenage grandson was shot and stabbed. Logan Mott, 15, is accused of killing his grandmother, Kristina French, 53, whose body was found in a shallow grave last Friday in Florida. Mott "adamantly denies any involvement in his grandmother's death.
- ◆ NBC News has fired Matt Lauer, *The Today Show* host, after a colleague accused him of "inappropriate sexual behavior in the workplace."
- ◆ The Senate passed a procedural vote on the tax bill that allows debate to begin on the measure with a final vote expected late Thursday or Friday. The procedural vote passed 52-48.

- **1874 -** British statesman Winston Churchill was born at Blenheim Palace in Oxfordshire. He became a British statesman, soldier, and author, and the first man to be made an honorary citizen of the United States (by an act of Congress on April 9, 1963).
- **1782** The United States and Britain signed preliminary peace articles in Paris, ending the Revolutionary War.
- **1835 -** Author Mark Twain was born Samuel Langhorne Clemens in Florida, Mo.
- **1966** The former British colony of Barbados became independent.
- **1993** President Bill Clinton signed into law the Brady bill, which requires a five-day waiting period for handgun purchases and background checks of prospective buyers.
