The trail head restroom, the playground restroom, the lake pavilion, and the concession stand restrooms at Regional Park will remain open throughout the winter. A portable restroom will be available at Prof Powers, Ingleside, and Heritage Parks until spring.

- ◆ The Skirball brush fire that caused residents of Los Angeles' affluent Bel-Air neighborhood to flee their multimillion-dollar mansions last week was sparked by an illegal cooking fire. The fire started at an encampment under Interstate 405 and Sepulveda Boulevard in Long Beach, then spread by arid landscapes and Santa Ana winds, which also fueled five other fires throughout the state last week. No arrests have been made.
- Palestinian President Mahmoud Abbas will not meet with U.S. Vice President Mike Pence during his upcoming trip to the Middle East because of the Trump administration's decision to acknowledge Jerusalem as the capital of Israel.
