Athens Man Killed In Mexico

An Athens man was among 12 people killed in a bus crash in Mexico this past Tuesday. He was identified as Bob Bever, a resident of the Cumberland Hills community between Athens and Englewood. Bever's wife, Barbara, and their two daughters were injured and are hospitalized in Mexico. The bus was in a convoy of buses that were carrying cruise ship passengers on an excursion to Mayan ruins in southeastern Mexico. They had been on the road for about 40 minutes before the accident. The bus flipped over on a narrow highway, killing 11 travelers and their guide, and injuring about 20 others, Royal Caribbean Cruises issued a statement saving that passengers from two of its ships, the Celebrity Equinox and Serenade of the Seas, were on the bus. At least one of the cruise ships had departed Fort Lauderdale, Florida, last Friday for a seven-day cruise. Mexican authorities believe the crash was caused by the driver's negligence and speed. Bever was retired from the Army and later worked in the trucking industry. His wife has been an employee at Mayfield Dairy. They were active members of St. Mary Catholic Church in Athens.


