◆ ATHENS CITY COUNCIL UPDATE

The Athens City Council held its monthly meeting on Tuesday night, and approved Derek Green to be the new Municipal Court Judge. Police Chief Cliff Couch gave a report on police activity for January. There were 82 thefts, 13 assaults, 11 burglaries, seven motor vehicle thefts, and one sex offense. Officers issued 221 citations for moving violations. There were 80 traffic accidents with seven injuries. There are two vacancies on the police department. Fire Chief Jim Dyer reported that firefighters responded to 53 calls, with a total loss of \$5,000.

♦ BILLY GRAHAM HAD TIES TO OUR AREA

Evangelist Billy Graham attended Bob Jones College (now Lee University) in Cleveland in 1936. Historians say at the age of 19, Graham preached his first sermon at the Charleston Methodist Church. Graham recalled that he got kicked out of Bob Jones when he approached the school's president and asked him to relax some of the strict rules. The story goes that the president pointed a finger at him and said, "young man, if you don't like it hear, you can leave. You'll never amount to anything but a backwoods Baptist preacher." Billy Graham held a 26-day crusade at the new Warner Field House in Chattanooga in 1953. The event became the first integrated crusade in the South. Graham asked an usher to remove the ropes separating the black and white sections of the audience. When the usher refused, Graham did it himself.
