#### ◆ ONLINE PAYMENT ALERT FROM AUB

More and more, customers of goods and services are choosing the convenience of paying bills online. However, customers must also be cautious about the website they visit and what payment service they are using--or believe they are using--to pay bills. AUB encourages customers to pay their utility bills online via the AUB website at www.aub.org. AUB's Wayne Scarbrough cautions that there are payment companies that mimic other company websites and then act as a payment processor for customers, often without the customer realizing they are paying a third party processor. Scarbrough says one such company that some AUB customers have encountered is Doxo.com. He says the company is not a scam, per se, but they fool people into thinking they are dealing with their local utility when they are not. He says the result can be fees for making the payment as well as a delayed payment to AUB that can lead to late fees or even a non-payment disconnect in the worst scenario. He says AUB is not affiliated with Doxo.com in any fashion. Scarbrough says to go to www.aub.org to be sure you are paying AUB directly.
