◆ A Washington state man has been charged with mailing more than a dozen packages to military bases and CIA headquarters in the Washington, D.C. area, with what appeared to be homemade explosive devices inside. After five suspicious packages were found earlier Tuesday, the FBI said it was possible others were mailed to additional mail processing facilities in or near the nation's capital.

◆ Kim Jong Un, communist dictator of North Korea, visited China in his first foreign trip since he came to power in 2011. Kim traveled to China with his wife, Ri Sol Ju, and spent Sunday through Wednesday there.

TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Despite gains earlier in the day, U.S. stocks closed down as the tech sector sold off sharply. Utilities and telecom sectors were the best performers benefiting from a decline in Treasury bond yields.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 345 points or 1.4% to 23,858. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 46 points or 1.7% to 2,613, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 212 points or 2.9% to 7,009. The 30-year Treasury yield closed lower at 3.03% and the 10-year Treasury yield finished lower at Iron Horse Hot Dogs & Chili, Etowah - 99 2.78%
