♦ MURDER VICTIM IDENTIFIED

An Athens man faces charges of first degree murder after a verbal dispute resulted in the fatal shooting of a woman who was renting his property. Sheriff Joe Guy says 77-year old Charles Ward was arrested in connection with the death of 60-year-old Kathleen Marie McKee, a renter who lived on Ward's property. Deputies were dispatched to a residence on County Road 652 last Thursday evening, after Ms Mckee called 911 to report an argument between herself and Ward, her landlord who lived next door. When deputies arrived at her residence they found her body inside. Ward was taken into custody and was booked into the McMinn County Jail under a 200-thousand-dollar bond.


