#### **♦**COOK PARK SHOOTING SUSPECT ARRESTED

Athens police have arrested a 15-year-old male in connection with a shooting that took place the night of August 12th in Cook Park. The victim, Willie Lusanne, Jr., told officers he had been involved in an argument with a 17-year-old male. He said the male left and returned with another male. The second male produced a shotgun and shot Lusanne in the thigh. Police Chief Cliff Couch says the 15-year-old believed to be responsible for the shooting was arrested early Thursday.

#### ◆ SATURDAY IS FREE HUNTING DAY

Tennessee residents are allowed to hunt without a license on Saturday, August 25th, which coincides with the opening day of squirrel season. In addition to the opening of squirrel season, it will be the middle day of the statewide three-day archery private lands only/antlered only deer season. Free Hunting Day is an event the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency provides annually in hopes of increasing interest in hunting. On Free Hunting Day, state resident hunters are exempt from hunting licenses and WMA permit requirements. The TWRA reminds you that hunter education requirements are not waived for Free Hunting Day. Anyone born on or after January 1st, 1969, is required to have successfully completed a hunter education course. Free hunting will be allowed for squirrels, armadillos, beavers, coyotes, groundhogs, and striped skunks.

# **National & World News**

- ♦ A former National Security contractor described by a federal prosecutor as a "quintessential example of an insider threat," was sentenced to five years in prison Thursday for leaking classified information to the media about a Russian hacking investigation.
- ♦ In a report by the UN's nuclear watchdog, North Korea's nuclear activities have not stopped over the past year and it continues to develop its nuclear program. Secretary of State Mike Pompeo will travel to Pyongyang next week, with the new Special Representative for North Korea, Steve Biegun.
- ◆ Congressman Duncan Hunter from California and his wife, Margaret, entered not guilty pleas in federal court in San Diego on Thursday. They're accused of misusing \$250,000 in campaign funds for personal expenses and filing false campaign finance records with the Federal Election Commission.
