#### RAIN TOTALS TOP 6 INCHES SO FAR

In the past three days, AUB has recorded just under 6 inches of rain (5.89) to be exact, and that does not include the rain that has fallen since 7 a.m. Thursday. AUB's Wayne Scarbrough says the rain has saturated and "softened" the soil. He says this soft soil sometimes allows large trees simply to fall over, pulling up roots and all at the base. The photo shows trees that did just that on County Rd 265. Scarbrough says don't be surprised to see this happen in the coming week or so, even if the day is beautiful and sunny. He says there are likely several big trees right on the edge of falling and can come down without warning

Christine Blasey Ford testified under oath before the Senate Judiciary Committee Thursday regarding her allegation that Supreme Court nominee Brett Kavanaugh sexually assaulted her 36 years ago. When questioned about her degree of certainty that she believed it was Brett Kavanaugh who assaulted her, her response was, "100 percent." Former sex crimes prosecutor Rachel Mitchell from Arizona, guestioned Ford on behalf of the Republicans. Later in the day and under oath, Kavanaugh offered an unequivocal denial that he sexually assaulted Ford: "I swear today, under oath, before the Senate and the nation, before my family and God, I am innocent of this charge." The committee vote is scheduled for today and the first procedural vote will take place on the Senate floor Saturday.

• A beluga whale has been spotted stranded in London in the River Thames. There are concerns that the whale may not be able to find his way back to the Arctic sea as he continues to move further into London. Rescue teams from The British Divers Marine Life Rescue are on standby. Beluga whales live in the Arctic Sea.
