◆ A burglary suspect was charged with several area thefts Halloween night. Sheriff Joe Guy says that several thefts from businesses and cars had occurred along Highway 11 south of Athens over the period of October 22-31. Items from the different businesses included auto repair parts, tools, power tools, construction equipment, and vehicle batteries, which totaled well over \$10,000. Surveillance video helped to identify the suspect's vehicle. Acting on a tip, deputies were



able to quickly locate the vehicle parked at the Ingleside Motel in Athens as well as the suspect, Justin E. Rogers, age 26, of 1206 Alpine Drive, Rossville, Georgia. Rogers is being held under bond in the McMinn County Jail for burglary and violation of probation. Several of the items stolen were in Rogers' possession. Property owners were contacted and several stolen items were returned to the rightful owners.

- President Trump was joined by Vice President Mike Pence at last night's campaign rally held at the McKenzie Arena in Chattanooga. Thousands of people began forming lines on Saturday to get into the Roundhouse, which only holds about 11,000 people. Some reports indicated that there was about twice that many outside the arena watching the President and Vice President on TV. Trump and Pence promoted Republican Senate candidate, Congressman Marsha Blackburn.
- ◆ Meanwhile, Democratic U.S. Senate candidate Phil Bredesen also came to Chattanooga yesterday. Bredesen says he's willing to work with President Donald Trump but will put Tennessee first if he is elected to the senate. Bredesen appeared at an interfaith prayer lunch Sunday in Chattanooga.
- ◆ Three Girl Scouts and an adult supervisor were killed when a pickup truck struck them as they were picking up trash alongside a Wisconsin highway on Saturday. The driver, Colten Treu, 21, is being held in jail on suspicion of homicide by intoxicated use of a vehicle and homicide by negligent use of a vehicle.
