◆ DECEMBER 5th IS FREE FLU SHOT DAY

County health departments across the state of Tennessee are giving out free flu shots next Wednesday, December 5th. The state health department says the annual flu season is expected to last many more weeks. Flu can be deadly, and state Health Commissioner John Dreyzehner says the vaccine can keep you from becoming ill. The McMinn County Health Department will provide flu shots December 5th at no cost from 9 a.m. to 12 noon at the health department, 393 County Road 554. The Meigs County Health Department will provide free flu shots on Dec. 5th from 9 a.m. to 12 noon at the Piggly Wiggly in Decatur.

National & World News

- ◆ Russia is bringing criminal charges against the sailors from the three Ukrainian navy ships that it seized close to Crimea over the weekend.
- ♦ A series of mysterious fatal shootings of California sea lions that washed up on shore in Seattle have federal authorities concerned for the mammals and for residents living near the Puget Sound. Bullet wounds were discovered in at least six of the 16 carcasses in King and Kitsap Counties of Washington state.
- ♦ House Democratic leader Nancy Pelosi is working to shore up support for her bid to be become speaker of the House in the 116th Congress. The Democratic caucus will vote on their leadership Wednesday, and even if Pelosi does not garner the votes needed, she will have six more weeks to firm up support, before the January 3rd floor vote.

TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks ended the day higher, with the best-performing sector being telecommunications. In economic news, the Consumer Confidence Index declined for the first time in five months.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 108 points or 0.4% to 24,749. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 9 points or 0.3% to 2,682, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 1 point to 7,083. In bond markets, the 30-year Treasury yield closed higher at 3.31% and the price of crude oil rose \$0.15 to \$51.78.
