◆ TEENAGER DROWNS IN OCOEE ACCIDENT

The teenage girl who fell off a raft during a whitewater rafting trip down the Ocoee River in Polk County has died. Yariennyz Hernandez, 15, was rafting with a church group from Florida this past Sunday. She fell off the raft and her ankle got wrapped up by a rescue rope, pulling her under water. The family decided to take her off life support this week.

◆ ETOWAH SCHOOL MOURNS LOSS OF STUDENT

The Etowah City School staff and students are mourning the loss of one of their own after she died tragically in a jet ski accident last week. Brianna Webb, 12, died while on a family vacation in Pensacola, Florida. She was a cheerleader and basketball player and would have been in the 7th grade this upcoming school year. Her teachers are putting together a video montage of memories from students and staff members. No date has been set for the funeral, but it will be held at Serenity Funeral Home. A GoFundMe page has been established for the family.

◆ NURSING AIDES FIRED IN ETOWAH

Two nursing aides at Etowah Health Care Center say they were fired for a social media post joking about the elderly. Cassie Moses and Symara Rakestraw were fired after posting a photo saying, "Felt cute...might drop your grandma later." The photo showed Rakestraw sitting in a special lift designed for the elderly and Moses was seen smiling in the front.

TWU Student Donates Organs

Lane Lusk, one of the two Tennessee Wesleyan University students critically injured in a traffic accident last Friday in Charleston, South Carolina, has died. Lane was being kept alive with a ventilator until his organs could be harvested. He underwent lengthy surgery Thursday afternoon to have his organs removed. According to a Facebook post from his mother, his heart will be going to a recipient in Tennessee and other organs will go to patients in South Carolina and Florida. Lane was from Knoxville. Meantime, the other TWU student who was injured, Kyle Blassingame of Athens, continues to improve. The Athens Movie Palace will host a blood drive with Medic Regional Blood Center on August 7th. \$15 per donor will be credited to Kyle for bloodrelated medical expenses.
