

### Tanks Fall; only Hydrant Ruptures

Last Thursday afternoon a 2008 model Volvo tractor-trailer, hauling chemical tanks, had 3 of the tanks fall from the rear of the trailer. One of those tanks hit a nearby fire hydrant on County Road 573, near Englewood. Fortunately none of the chemical tanks ruptured, only the fire hydrant. There were no injuries. The chemical was identified as Dimethyl-m-propylamine, which is flammable and corrosive. The Englewood and Athens Rural Fire Departments, McMinn County Sheriff's Department and the THP all responded with THP Officer Rodney Best investigating the accident.
