Man Killed in Home Invasion

An Athens man is dead after apparently attempting to invade a residence and firing a shot at another person. Sheriff Joe Guy says deputies were called to a residence on County Road 114 around

1:30 a.m. Sunday on a report of shots fired. When they arrived, they found 39-yearold Sante Mack lying in the yard with a gunshot wound. Deputies



rendered aid to the wounded man as detectives responded. Sheriff Guy says it appears Mack had been at the residence Saturday evening and had a previous relationship with a female who lived there. Guy says Mack apparently returned to the residence and attempted to enter through a window. When the residents confronted him, Mack assaulted one of the females with the gun and fired a shot at them. A male in the residence was also armed and fired a shot that struck Mack. Mack fell outside and the residents called 911.
