MCSO & DTF Make Large Meth Bust

◆ An ongoing Methamphetamine trafficking investigation has netted over 2 pounds of meth and \$68,000 in drug money. On the evening of September 11th, agents with the 10th Drug Task Force and the McMinn Co. Sheriff's Office served a search warrant at a residence on Highway 68 in the Sweetwater section of McMinn County. During the search, agents allegedly found about 2.2 pounds of meth and \$55,000 in cash at the home of Martin Chouinard. He was arrested and charged with Possession of Schedule II Methamphetamine for resale and possession of drug paraphernalia. During the investigation, another suspect identified as Lance Farrell fled from the scene on a motorcycle. He was apprehended with the assistance of McMinn County Deputies and allegedly had in his possession over 30 grams of meth and over \$13,000 in cash. Farrell was charged with felony evading arrest and faces numerous drug charges. Both men were booked into the McMinn County Jail. Chouinard is pictured below left and Farrell is on the right.
