# **AUB Power Rates to Fall**

◆ Local electric power rates will fall in October as TVA moves away from summertime basic rates. The residential power rate for Athens Utilities Board (AUB) customers in October will be \$0.08525 per kilowatt hour compared to September's rate of \$0.09038. October and November carry the lowest base rates of the year according to AUB's Wayne Scarbrough. Scarbrough also noted that this October will be the first time in six years that TVA has not levied a wholesale rate increase on AUB.

## **National and World News**

- ◆ New York state banned the sale of flavored e-cigarettes amid growing national concern about the safety of the products. The ban went into effect after approval by the state's Public Health and Health Planning Council Tuesday afternoon. New York is the first state to enact such a ban, but Michigan lawmakers have approved a similar ban and are working out details.
- ◆ Renowned ABC News journalist and political commentator Cokie Roberts has died at the age of 75 due to complications from breast cancer. Roberts won countless awards throughout her decades-long career including three Emmys. She has been inducted into the Broadcasting and Cable Hall of Fame. She was cited by the American Women in Radio and Television as one of the 50 greatest women in the history of broadcasting, and was named a "Living Legend" by the Library of Congress in 2008.

TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks closed mostly higher ahead of tomorrow's widely expected Fed rate cut. Interest-rate-sensitive sectors performed well. Energy and industrials sectors lagged. Treasury bond prices rose, and interest rates

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 34 points or 0.1% to 27,111. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 7 points or 0.2% to 3,005, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 32 points or 0.4% to 8,186.
