WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks closed slightly higher. The technology, materials and industrials sectors led the market. The Federal Reserve held its benchmark interest rates steady at its current target range of 1.5 to 1.75 percent. Treasury interest rates fell slightly.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 30 points or 0.1% to 27,911. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 9 points or 0.3% to 3,142, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 38 points or 0.4% to 8,654.
