Former Detective Sentenced

A former McMinn County Sheriff's Detective will spend two years in prison after pleading guilty to an identity theft charge. Joshua Rhodes admitted to Federal Court Judge Curtis Collier that he used a credit card taken from a suspect to make nearly \$27,000 in purchases in 2016. Rhodes was fired from the sheriff's department later that year. Rhodes will be required to pay restitution. He reports to prison on February 24th.
