## **Council Approves School Project**

The Athens City Council has given unanimous approval to a resolution affirming council support of the building program for the Athens City Schools. The resolution states that the project should be done in phases starting with the City Park site. Phase 1 would be the commons areas and Pre-K through 2nd grade portion of the school, which would be built first with an estimated cost of \$30 million. Phase 2 would be the 3rd through 5th grade wing of the building in 2026 with a cost of \$20 million. The third phase would be in 2030 and would involve renovations to the present Athens City Middle School.

The council also heard reports from the police and fire chiefs about activity in November.

Police Chief Cliff Couch reported 39 thefts in November, 9 assaults, five motor vehicle thefts, four burglaries, and two sex offenses. There were 90 traffic crashes, with 8 injuries.

Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth said firefighters responded to 66 calls in November, with losses totaling \$95,565.00.
