COVID-19 News & Updates

- Life Care Center of Athens reports a total of 93 residents and employees have tested positive for Covid-19. Of that total, 2 residents have been hospitalized and 1 has died. New admissions have been halted.
- The TN Dept. of Health reports that as of Sunday, there were 100 cases in McMinn County that tested positive for the virus with 11 recovered and 1 death; in Meigs County 9 positive with 4 recovered; in Monroe County 21 positive with 11 recovered and 1 death; in Polk County 11 cases with 6 recovered. death; in Polk County 11 cases with 6 recovered.
- ◆ Barber shops, beauty salons, nail spas, massage therapy services, tanning beds and other close-contact services will be allowed to reopen on May 6th. There will be strict guidelines, including a limit on the number of customers, walk-ins are not allowed only appointments, workstations must be at least 6 feet apart, waiting areas will be eliminated, enhanced sanitization of commonly touched surfaces and equipment will be required, and both customers and employees will be required to wear face cov-

State and Area News

- ✓ The Great Smoky Mountains National Park plans to start opening on May 9th. Many of the roads and trails in the park will be the first to reopen. Campgrounds, picnic pavilions, visitor centers, and many secondary roads will remain closed during the first reopening phase, which is expected to last for at least two weeks.
- ✓ The number of Tennessee residents who filed new unemployment claims topped 43,700, bringing the total number of requests for benefits to more than 435,000 since businesses began closing in response to the new coronavirus outbreak. The Tennessee Department of Labor & Workforce Development on Thursday reported new jobless claims for the week ending April 25th. The highest number of new claims was reported in the counties surrounding Metro Nashville / Davidson County. The amount of Tennessee residents seeking unemployment benefits has spiked since many businesses closed in March. Roughly 30.3 million people in the U.S. have now filed for jobless aid.
- ✓ Tennessee Governor Bill Lee was the only state elected official to join President Trump, administration officials, and advocates for senior citizens at the White House on Thursday to announce new measures to keep senior citizens safe during the coronavirus crisis. Governor Lee has committed to testing every resident and staff member in every one of the state's 700-plus senior living facilities and nursing homes. President Trump said his administration will also send more personal protective equipment to the nursing home facilities and ramp up inspections as states like Tennessee continue to reopen.
