Friday's Coronavirus Update

As of Thursday afternoon, the Tennessee Department of Health reported there have been 14,096 confirmed cases of the coronavirus in Tennessee and there have been 237 deaths in the state. (The number of deaths was adjusted downward from 239 reported on Wednesday) McMinn County's total now stands at 108 cases. Fourteen of the patients have recovered. The number of deaths remains at three. Bradley County's total is 64 cases, with 48 recovered and one death. Monroe County has 26 cases, 15 have recovered, and one patient has died. Meigs County's total stands at 17 cases of the virus, with six patients recovered.

MORE VIRUS-RELATED NEWS

- ✓ Small group, non-contact recreation businesses like bowling alleys and mini-golf will be able to reopen today. The guidelines recommend capacity limits, spacing requirements, and frequent sanitization.
- ✓ The Great Smoky Mountains National Park will reopen many roads and trails this weekend. New safety measures will be implemented including reduced group size limits, disinfectant fogging for restrooms and public buildings, and installation of plexiglass shields at visitor centers.
- ✓ The University of Tennessee system is planning to welcome students back to each of its campuses for the fall semester. It's expected that wearing masks and temperature checks will be a part of the fall semester requirements.

Arrest Made in Athens Murder

The Athens Police Department has released the identity of the young woman who was shot to death at the Clem Jones Housing Complex on Walker Street this past Tuesday morning. She was 27-year-old Layla Clair Wilson Long. On Tuesday, May 5th, at approximately 12:15 a.m., officers were called to Clem Jones Housing Complex in reference to a shooting that had occurred in

an apartment. When they arrived, they found two victims. A man identified as Tremon Hall was treated at Starr Regional Medical Center and then released. Ms. Long died at the scene. Following an investigation, officers obtained arrest warrants for two suspects for First Degree Murder and Attempted First Degree Murder. Wednesday evening, one of the suspects, identified as Johnathan Clayton of CR 78, Riceville, was taken into custody in Sweetwater by the Ath-



ens Police Department's SWAT Team with help from the Sweetwater Police Department and the Drug Task Force. The second suspect was identified as Joseph Kibodeaux who remains at large. Anyone with information regarding his whereabouts is asked to call 911. He may be armed and dangerous. Athens Police Chief Cliff Couch says Detectives Blake Witt, Nick Purkey, and Freddy Shultz and numerous other officers spent countless hours trying to get justice for the victims and get the suspects off the street.
