Fatal Boat Crash on Watts Bar Lake

An Ooltewah man died this past Saturday night due to injuries received in a single vessel boating accident on Watts Bar Lake. The incident took place near Blue Springs Marina in Roane County just before 6 p.m. The victim was identified as Don Campbell, 55. The TWRA says Campbell's wife was injured and was airlifted to UT Medical Center in critical condition. A child on the boat was treated for injuries and then released to family members. TWU Has Record Enrollment

Tennessee Wesleyan University (aerial view below) welcomed a record number of students for the fall semester. The total enrollment is 1,168. That marks the second consecutive year of record enrollment for TWU. TWU has a record of 112 graduate students this semester, thanks in part to the newest class of Master of Occupational Therapy students at the Knoxville instructional site. The RN to BSN program, which allows registered nurses to complete their bachelor's degrees online through the TWU Fort Sanders School of Nursing, enrolled 55 students, up 16 from last fall. TWU continues to serve students who are the first in their family to attend college, with 39% of the undergraduate population identifying as first generation students.
