TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Equities finished higher, but closed lower than session highs as headline and core CPI inflation came in below forecasts for the month of November. The S&P 500 was up around 0.3%. The tech-heavy NASDAQ climbed over 1.0%. Bond yields fell. The 10-year U.S. Treasury yield fell about 0.09%. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 103.60 to 34,108.64. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 29.09 to 4,019.65, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 113.08 to 11,256.81.
