1669 - Susannah Wesley was born. She was the mother of 19 children, including John Wesley who founded the Methodist Church.

1885 - The roller coaster was patented by La Marcus Thompson of, where else, Coney Island, NY. His coaster was 450 feet long with the highest drop being 30 feet.

1894 - Harold Gray, creator of the "Little Orphan Annie" comic strip, was born.

MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT Markets closed lower as investor sentiment continues to sour. Last week's weakness was attributed to Fed Chair Powell's hawkish comments around monetary policy. Bonds were higher. The 10-year yield was around 3.94%. Oil was up. Investors expect a strong oil demand from China as its economy reopens. At the closing bell, the Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 162.92 to 32,757.54. The S&P 500 was down 34.70 to 3,817.66, and The Nasdaq Composite was down 159.38 to 10,546.03.
