### **TDOT Statewide Repaying Efforts**

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) is ramping up its pavement repair efforts to address those lingering potholes from January's record storm. The department is investing an additional \$15 million in a total of 121 various projects statewide over and above their annual work program. Transportation Modernization Act dollars were accelerated to supplement the state repair and maintenance budget. Warmer temperatures in the spring and early summer months mean asphalt plants are regularly producing the hot mix needed for more permanent repairs. Most of the projects will involve milling - the removal of the top layer and paving with a layer of fresh asphalt. There are two locations in east Tennessee in which they will be performing concrete rehabilitation of two bridges. In some cases, motorists should be prepared for short-term traffic delays during these operations. While every effort will be made to perform repairs during off-peak travel times (9:00 a.m. -3:00 p.m. weekdays), some lane closures may extend into the late afternoon, evening, and weekends.. Please note – inclement weather, emergency repairs or incidents may disrupt daily schedules. Drivers can report potholes by calling the TDOTFIX Hotline at 833-TDOTFIX or by submitting an online maintenance request form.

### **Teacher Faces Multiple Child Sex Crimes**



Per Hope McAlee of WATE.com, Nathan McKinley Maples, 32 of Sevier County faces multiple child sex crime charges and has been suspended indefinitely while the legal process unfolds. The school administrators received a report from a parent on February 19 alleging inappropriate conduct between

Maples and their child. The school system immediately involved law enforcement and connected the family and investigators. Maples was brought to the Central Office the next morning and suspended. The charges include four counts of statutory rape by an authority figure, one count of continuous sexual abuse of a child, one count of aggravated sexual battery, one count of sexual exploitation of a child, and one count of exploitation of a minor by electronic means, as per an eight-count indictment. ### **TODAY IN HISTORY-MAY 6**

**1856 -** Sigmund Freud, the father of psychoanalysis, was born in Freiberg, Moravia (present-day Pribor, Czech Republic).

**1861 -** Arkansas seceded from the Union.

**1915** - Babe Ruth of the Boston Red Sox hit the first of his 714 major league home runs in a 4-3 loss to the New York Yankees at the Polo Grounds.

**1937 -** The Hindenburg disaster took place. The German dirigible exploded in flames as it was landing at Lakehurst, New Jersey, after a trans-Atlantic crossing. Thirty-six people died. The crash was described in a live radio broadcast.

**1954** - The world's first four-minute mile was run on this date in Oxford, England. The man who broke the barrier was 25-year-old Roger Bannister.

**2002 -** "Spider-Man" became the first movie to make more than \$100 million in its opening weekend.
